The theory sessions were conducted by Dr. Jaikumar Mulchandani, DNB (General medicine), IDCCM, FRCP (UK) while Mrs. Ujjwala Murkute, Assoc. Professor & Mrs. Jyoti Devare Lecturer, Sadhu Vaswani CON assisted in conduction of workstations. The program was conducted at Sadhu Vaswani College of nursing. Handouts on BLS and ACLS were made and distributed to all the participants before the starting of the session for their reference.

Refreshments including morning and evening tea was organized by Inlaks & Budhrani hospital canteen for the participants.

The training program started with introduction to BLS by Dr. Jaikumar Mulchandani, I & B hospital where he briefed about the algorithm of BLS and about indicators of good CPR. Demonstration of airway and breathing along with use of defibrillator was done with the active participation from group members. All participants were divided in group for practice of workstation after first session.

After the BLS workstations, a theory class on ACLS, its algorithm, dysrhythmias and it's management was taken by Dr. Jaikumar Mulchandani. In this session, normal ECG, important life threatening dysrhythmias placement of advanced airways, Defibrillation and cardioversion were discussed with suitable examples.

After lunch break, group was divided into 4-5 different groups for practice session on ACLS. All the participant practiced insertion of various artificial airways, recognition of ECG rhythm, use of anti-dysrhythmic medication and CPR in groups. The groups were supervised and helped by Mrs. Ujjwala M and Mrs. Jyoti D along with Dr. Jaikumar. At the end of practice session each group was given a practice scenario and were asked to enact the scenario where they could apply what they had learned in theory and workstation sessions.




