Introduction:

The NSS unit of Sadhu Vaswani College of Nursing planned 17th NSS special camp from **03/03/2024 to 9/03/2024** at Wankhalwadi Kandroli. Information regarding special camp was sent to university a week before of the camp. The program officers visited the camp site in advance and arranged all of the arrangements for the week's events. The NSS Asst. Programme Officers visited the Gram panchayat sadasay's office, Sadhu Vaswani Ashram Mission Medical complex, Principal of Zillah Parishad School & villagers & decided about the camp. The residential camp was organized. All the necessary precautions were taken to manage any emergency situation.

Daily Activities:-

Day 1 Sunday : -03/03/2024

Around 12 p.m., all 25 students and two SVCON faculty members, Ms. Namrata Khandagle and Ms. Smita Padale, departed Pune and arrived in Wankhalwadi at 4:00 p.m. After reaching in village arrangement of all articles was done by the students. The NSS camp activities were briefed. Students displayed good cooperation.

Day 2: Monday– 04/03/2024:-

Inauguration programme

The day began with exercise at 6:00 am in morning. After the daily essential activities and breakfast, students gathered for sanctuary at 8:30 am. After that student went for preparation of NSS inauguration programme. **Inauguration programme** started at 10:30am at Datha Mandir next

to Zila prashad school, Honourable guests were- Mr. Shrikant Pokale, Teacher of Zila prarishad Schoolteacher and Mr. Pandurang Wage, Ms. Namrata Khandagle and Ms. Smita Padale. Mr. **Ravi Pawar also appreciated the efforts taken by the students gave lecture on village development activites in tribal areas**

The programme started with prayer song sung by the Nss volunteers. After lighting the lamp, the guests of the programme were greeted & welcomed with tusli sapling and felicitated with coconut by NSS volunteers as a token of respect. There was a welcome speech performed by NSS volunteers. The chief guests inaugurated the THEME was reviled by cutting the ribbon “**Sarve Santu Niramaya**”. NSS song was sung by NSS volunteers. After the inauguration, the NSS volunteers, programme officers and chief guests of the village along with the school children went for tree plantation programme. 05 trees(2 Guava plants, 2 Jamun plants and 1 Jackfruit plant) were planted near the ZP school and in its surrounding. Each tree was allotted for school children to take care and nurture them. Students also did propaganda about the NSS camp activities among the villagers.

Day 3 : 05/03/2024- Tuesday

Rally on healthy heart and mind

The day began with exercise at 6:30 am in morning. After the daily essential activities and breakfast, students gathered for sanctuary at 8:30 am. from 9:30am to 12pm NSS volunteers

conducted rally on healthy heart in the Wankhalwadi village. Volunteers prepared pluck cards for educating people. School children also joined the volunteers for the rally. Students performed role play on basic life support and first aid health talk on heat stroke and its prevention, Skit on prevention of dog bite and importance of rabies vaccination and Fracture and its primary treatment and demonstrate bandaging. All the villagers appreciated and took home the message on healthy heart and first aid management. The villagers appreciated the efforts taken by the students. End of the program the students were served snacks

Day 4th: 06/03/2024- Wednesday

School Health programme:

Time: 3pm to 6pm

Venue: ZP Primary School, Wankhalwadi, Kandroli.

The day began with exercise at 6:30 am in morning. After the daily essential activities and breakfast, students gathered for sanctuary at 8:30 am. Took the students for a short outing at a nearby temple as most of the villages had gone for wedding

So the School health program was conducted from 4 pm to 6 pm on 21 primary school children. 20 students were underweight, 13 had dental carrier, 3 students complained chest pain. 13 students had lymph nodes enlargement most of them on the neck and few in axial. Report given to the school teacher to take further action.

Followed by the assessment, nutritional awareness and personal hygiene exhibition for school children was arranged. NSS volunteers explained about the balanced diet, what to eat and what not to. Explained the important of personal hygiene. Distributed bananas to the students. They were very much excited to learn and responded very well.

Day 5th: 07/03/2024- Thursday

Rally on vector borne disease

The students started the day with physical exercise at 6:00 am which enabled them to strengthen their physical being. After warming up, the physical exercise for an hour from 6:00 am – 7:00 am. Student spent their time in personal activities and then had their breakfast at 8:00 am which

was followed by the sanctuary at 8:30 am. The sanctuary consists of college song, spiritual song, etc.

NSS volunteers conducted rally on vector borne disease in the Wankhalwadi village. Volunteers prepared pluck cards for educating people. School children also joined the volunteers for the rally. Students performed role play on prevention of vector borne disease, but had less number of villagers as they had gone for work in the morning.

So the same rally was conducted in the evening with role play on prevention of vector borne disease and on basic life support, about 40 villagers witness the role play. Gram Panchayat Sadasya Mr. Ravi Pawar also appreciated the efforts taken by the students. End of the program the students and guest were served snacks. Thanked the villagers and the program ended successful.

Day 6 : 08/03/2024- Friday

Culture program

The day began with exercise at 6:30 am in morning. After the daily essential activities and breakfast, students gathered for sanctuary at 8 am. Culture program was organized in evening. Welcomed the guest and the villagers, with pray song.
